Dear Fellow Enthusiast,

This year's event is the 64th Cork Veteran Run, the first Run took place in 1956 and the event has been held every year since then. As before, there will be two routes, a short run of 50 miles and a longer run of 80 miles for those who prefer a greater distance. You can choose either route, they will both go to the lunch halt at Garryvoe Hotel and to the finish at The Brook Inn. This year's run will start at Kearys BMW, Eastgate, Little Island, Co. Cork (Sat Nav N51° 54.29' W8° 21.42'). Check-in opens at 9.30am, where tea & coffee will be available. The run starts at 11am. Lunch will be available at Garryvoe Hotel at €15.50 each including tea/coffee.

Concours awards will be given out at prizegiving at the finish at The Brook Inn, Sallybrook (which is near to the morning Start). The CAB Cup	for the best car
The Joe Jackson Cup	for the best motorcycle
The Mayfield Cup	for the best unrestored motorcycle
The Henry Ford Trophy	for the best Model T Ford
The Alkin Cup	for the car that travels the furthest distance to the event
The Munster Motor Cycle & Car Club Cup	for the motorcycle that travels the furthest distance to the event

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

All entrants will be made Temporary Members of the Munster Vintage Motor Cycle and Car Club for the duration of the event. Entry Fee is €19.00; non MVMCCC members must pay a Temporary Club Membership Fee of €1.00

ELIGIBLE VEHICLES:

Any mechanically propelled vehicle manufactured prior to 31/12/1978 (Invitees to 31/12/1988 or other suitable vehicles at the discretion of the Organisers).

ROUTE:

Each entrant will receive a route sheet & one number which must be affixed to the vehicle

INSURANCE:

All vehicles must be roadworthy and covered by Insurance. Proof of insurance must be available on request.

DANGEROUS DRIVING:

Entrants deemed to be driving dangerously will be excluded from the event.

ITEMS not covered in these regulations will be decided in accordance with the generally accepted rules of the Organising Bodies.

Closing Date for Entries: 20 July 2019. Please send in your entries early to allow us produce a full and accurate entry list. Those who enter on the day may not be guaranteed a Starter's Award.
