SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The event will be held under Irish Vintage Society permit/insurance.

Paid up MVMCCC participating members will be registered as members of the I.V.S.

Non MVMCCC members will be deemed visitors, I.V.S. registration not required.

ELIGIBLE VEHICLES:

Any mechanically propelled vehicle manufactured up to and including 1995.

Please Note: To Comply with Permit/Insurance Regulations the 1995 Cut-off Date MUST be strictly adhered to. Please comply or your entry will be REFUSED.

ROUTE:

Each entrant will receive a route sheet & a number which must be affixed to the vehicle.

INSURANCE:

All vehicles must be roadworthy and covered by Insurance. Proof of insurance must be available on request.

All drivers/riders must have a valid Driving Licence.

DANGEROUS DRIVING:

Entrants deemed to be driving dangerously will be excluded from the event.

ITEMS not covered in these regulations will be decided in accordance with the generally accepted rules of the Organising Bodies.
